ASPIRE Center for Learning and Development is pleased to announce an immediate opening for a contractual/per-diem New York State Licensed Psychologist (license-eligible will be considered) or Clinical Social Worker to join our treatment team.

ASPIRE Center is a unique private outpatient clinic with two locations in Melville, NY (on Long Island's Nassau/Suffolk County border). We offer a wide range of therapeutic programming to clients across the lifespan, including individual and family therapy, social coping groups, professional consultation and training, and comprehensive diagnostic evaluation. The clinicians at ASPIRE Center specialize in Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)/Asperger's, ADHD/executive functioning deficits, complex co-occurring conditions, and other social, emotional, and adjustment-related concerns (e.g., anxiety disorders, pragmatic language deficits, disruptive behavior, puberty and sexuality).

The available position primarily involves carrying an individual therapy caseload and, given interest and experience, facilitating weekly groups. A licensed psychologist may also have the opportunity to participate as part of our multidisciplinary evaluation team. Employment as an independent contractor enables flexibility in structuring workdays, hours, and caseload to meet scheduling preferences. However, the majority of therapy clients are seen during late afternoons, evenings, and weekends due to the nature of outpatient practice.

A clinician with CBT/eclectic orientation and commitment to evidence-based practice will find ASPIRE Center to be a collegial, supportive, and satisfying environment in which to work. Background and interest in working with children, teens, and young adults is a must. Experience with a bright, verbal ASD population is ideal; however, a strong candidate who is motivated to develop this additional speciality area through clinical supervision will be considered. If mutually desired, there may be room for growth into a full-time position as a staff clinician.
